

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






# **Milestones**

Before Greenfield existed as it does today, it all started with a toll station along Greenfield Road. The High family kept the name Greenfield to pay homage to it's history and humble beginnings.



the 1960s when Dale and Cal High began building and leasing industrial properties on a landlocked parcel south of Route 30.

Realizing the potential for growth, they formed a new company, High Properties. Soon they invested in expanding the enterprise with the acquisition of two farms on the north side of the highway.

During the 1970s, High Properties built new industrial buildings that formed the core of the park. Selected areas were designated as green space to preserve the natural beauty.

About the toll station: "In addition they were given, free of rent, 'one-half of the gatehouse.' The toll house was located on a site now occupied by a double frame house opposite the schoolhouse at Greenfield Road.


















# 3. Environmental Stewardship
